Package Overview

This seven day conservation legacy journey is designed for discerning, philanthropy minded travellers who value exclusive access, verified impact, and behind the scenes wildlife conservation experiences. The safari begins immediately with a private transfer to Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary, where guests take part in rhinoceros tracking and an official rhinoceros naming ceremony supported by a personalised audited giveback ledger. The journey then continues to Murchison Falls National Park for the iconic top of the falls experience, private game drives, and a premium Nile boat safari before flying by private charter to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. The final section focuses on mountain gorilla trekking and community conservation, ending with a smooth charter flight back to Entebbe. This is not simply a wildlife itinerary, it is positioned as a conservation legacy journey where the guest leaves a verified impact connected to their name.

Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival and Private Transfer to Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary

Arrive at Entebbe International Airport, where you receive a VIP meet and greet from your Urban Jay Safaris representative. You then begin the journey without a wasted arrival day, travelling by private road transfer through scenic countryside to Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary, Uganda's only rhinoceros conservation area. This immediate immersion into conservation sets the tone for the safari and allows guests to begin the legacy experience from the first day. Dinner and overnight are at Amuka Safari Lodge.

Day 2: Rhino Tracking and Official Naming Ceremony

The day begins with a behind the scenes conservation briefing with the Head Warden, followed by guided on foot rhinoceros tracking inside Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary. Guests then participate in an official rhinoceros naming ceremony, receiving a permanent conservation record and a personalised third party verified giveback ledger. This signature experience is the heart of the journey and cannot be replicated by standard safaris because it connects the traveller directly to a verified conservation legacy. Dinner and overnight are again at Amuka Safari Lodge.

Day 3: To Murchison Falls and the Nile Revealed

After breakfast, travel to Murchison Falls National Park, where the Nile reveals one of its most dramatic natural spectacles. Visit the top of Murchison Falls, where the river forces through a narrow seven metre gorge, and take a guided walk along the falls crest for views of the rushing water and surrounding landscape. Later, check in at a luxury lodge overlooking the Nile. An optional night game drive can be arranged for guests who would like an additional wildlife experience. Dinner and overnight are at Nile Safari Lodge.

Day 4: Big Game and Private Nile Boat Safari

Begin with an early morning private game drive in the Delta area of Murchison Falls National Park, a prime habitat for lion, elephant, giraffe, buffalo, and leopard. The private game drive allows a flexible pace and strong photography opportunities in the morning light. In the afternoon, take a private Nile boat cruise to the base of Murchison Falls, with close range wildlife viewing along the river and premium photographic access to riverbank species. This day combines classic savannah safari with river based luxury. Dinner and overnight are at Nile Safari Lodge.

Accommodation: Nile Safari Lodge | Meals: Breakfast,Lunch,Dinner | Destination: Murchison Falls National Park

Day 5: Private Charter Flight to Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

After breakfast, take a scenic private charter flight from Murchison Falls to the Bwindi region, showcasing Uganda's changing landscapes from open savannah to highland rainforest. This premium routing eliminates the long road transfer and preserves time and comfort for the guest. On arrival, transfer to a forest edge lodge and receive an afternoon gorilla trekking briefing in preparation for the next day's experience. Dinner and overnight are at Mahogany Springs.

Day 6: Mountain Gorilla Trekking and Community Conservation Visit

Start early for guided mountain gorilla trekking in Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. With ranger guides leading the way, trek through the forest until the assigned gorilla family is located. Once found, you spend one regulated hour with the habituated gorilla family, one of the world's most exclusive and moving wildlife encounters. In the afternoon, enjoy a community conservation visit followed by a private farewell dinner. Dinner and overnight are at Mahogany Springs.

Accommodation: Mahogany Springs | Meals: Breakfast,Lunch,Dinner | Destination: Bwindi Impenetrable National Park

Day 7: Return Charter Flight to Entebbe and Departure

After breakfast, fly back to Entebbe by charter flight. A day room at Protea Hotel or a similar property can be provided for relaxation before the international departure. This final day is arranged for smooth, stress free departure handling, allowing guests to conclude the conservation legacy journey in comfort.
